That is to say that if a European falls ill he goes to his family doctor, but an Abyssinian goes to his medicinal plants.

But not all Abyssinians are in the same condition. There are few who lead a better life thanks to the political and economic power they have. For example, the Eritrean ruling class travels many times to Europe and neighboring Arab countries for further treatment when they feel that home treatment is not enough. Take a look at the footnote to observe the women's dress of this class versus that of the lower class, of course, in the ruling class journal, Haddas Ertra.

So, I feel very honored to propose the following beautiful bird, ውፍመስቀል (black sparrow that changes its feathers in September) and a geranium plant/ ዕምባባመስቀል, full of futurity, prosperity and hope, to be the gift of the Eritrean people on New Year 2023.
